What is a Self Directed IRA?



A Self Directed IRA is the "true" form of IRA. When Congress created the Individual Retirement Arrangement (IRA) in 1974 the idea was simple.

**To allow you to grow your investment faster by giving IRA accounts
TAX FREE STATUS
during the accumulation period**

However, over the years many IRA Companies placed artificial restrictions on IRA owners. These restrictions limit what investments your IRA can hold. It is important to note that these restrictions are artificial and not part of the original ACT.

Unlike most IRA companies, a Self Directed IRA Company follows the original 1974 Act (as written and amended) and allows the IRA owner (you) to select investment that are best for your future. Self Directed IRA companies do not place artificial restrictions on the investor.

Common investment people make in a Self Directed IRA included:

- Real Estate
- Lending Money (Promissory Notes - Hard Money Loans)
(i.e. let your IRA be the bank)
- Private Placements (such as unlisted stocks)
- Tax Liens
